To add these extra elements, you'll want numbers for the face of the clock, a protractor, a stand or wall hook, and paint, stencils or interesting embellishments you can glue onto the plate. To begin, lay your plate flat on a folded towel. Use the ruler to find the middle of the plate and mark it with the pencil.

Instructions Paint the paper plate and leave it to dry (or colour it with afelt tip pen). Cut two pieces of coloured cardboard for the hands, making one smaller than the other (for the hour and minute hands). Using a coloured felt pen which blends in well with the clock face colouring, write in the numbers.

You can also substitute by using two large white paper plates. With the leftover green paper, cut about a 4-inch arrow that will represent the minute hand.
