In Texas, for parents who reside 100 miles or less apart, the Standard Possession Order gives the possessory conservator (the non-custodial parent) possession of the child on the 1st, 3rd, and 5th weekends throughout the year beginning at 6 p.m. on Friday and ending at 6 p.m. the following Sunday, as well as Thursdays of each week during the school year beginning at 6 p.m. and ending at 8 p.m.

2020 Expanded Standard Visitation Calendar in Texas. A standard possession order is defined by the Texas Family Code Section 153.252 and is intended to protect the best interest of the children. For parents who live within 100 miles of each other, the secondary parent will get the child every Thursday during the school year from 6 to 8 pm; every 1st, 3rd, and 5th weekend of a month from Friday to Sunday; 30 days during the summer; and every other Spring Break.

The standard possession order gives the non-custodial parent 30 days with the child during summer. The summer stay goes from July 1 to 31, unless the non-custodial parent notifies the other parent prior to April 1 that he or she prefers different days. The custodial parent gets one weekend with the child during this time.

### **Anonymous Interview**

Per an SPO, your dates are chosen for you if you do not select your days on time. If you live within 100 miles from the child, you get July 1 to July 30. For parents living outside 100 miles, it's June 15 to July 27. Summer possession time is also special because it traditionally coincides with the Father's day season.
